It's the time of the season...

Reminders for the cold and flu season:

- If your child is sick, you should keep them home. Letting them get rest and plenty of fluid is the best way to allow their immune system to strengthen. Also, when it comes to germs, we do not encourage sharing.
- If your child needs medicine, you need to fill out a Medicine Form. In most cases, we will not give Tylenol to keep a fever down— if the child has a fever of 100 or higher, they will not be able to stay at the center.
- All children go outside every day. Please make sure that your child has a coat, snow pants, boots, hat, and mittens. It's a good idea to have a few pairs of mittens so if one pair gets lost, or gets too wet, there is another pair to spare! If your child is too sick to go outside, they are too sick to be at Apple Tree.
- Keep your Emergency Contact Card up to date. If you have changed phone numbers or jobs, you need to make sure we have the correct numbers. It is very important that we are able to contact you in an emergency.

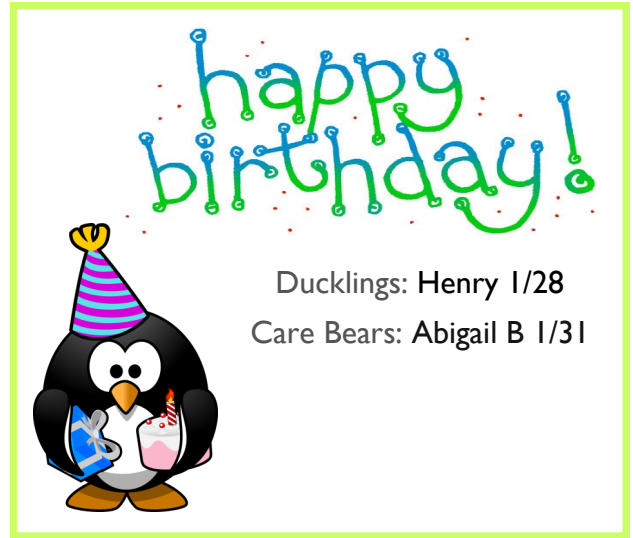
We participate in the Child and Adult Care Food Program. CACFP is available to all participants without regard to race, color, nationality, religious origin, sex or disability.
